Schools will ensure students experience...

Ongoing	 quality teaching and learning, including daily reading, writing and mathematics lessons, with embedded opportunities to work independently. a positive and relaxed learning environment.
The month before administration	 reassurance about the assessment and its purpose (e.g., assessment results help teachers and schools support student learning). reassurance that everything they have been learning in school has prepared them for the assessment.
1-2 weeks before administration	 the assessment question formats by participating in mini lessons as outlined in the Sample Questions Instructions document. opportunities to discuss and share thinking strategies involved in responding to questions.
During the administration	 a calm and supportive environment (consider incorporating well-being strategies such as physical activity, relaxation techniques, healthy snacks).
