- Nova Scotia Examinations: Administration dates for the Nova Scotia Examinations are fixed and set annually by the department.
- Nova Scotia Assessments: When scheduling assessments within the allotted period, the following requirements must be met:
 - Assessments must be completed in the mornings of the school’s chosen dates; chosen administration dates do not need to be consecutive, but the assessment sections must be administered in the sequence of the booklet’s order (Day 1, Day 2; Literacy/ Reading and Writing will be written before Mathematics/Mathématiques).
 - Students must complete only one section (“Day”) of the assessment per day.
 - Make-up days must be completed by the end of the administration period to allow for return of materials on/before the deadline.
