The Nova Scotia Examination: English 10 (E10) will be administered on January 27, 2025.

- **New in 2024-2025:** The eligibility criteria for read-aloud adaptations, whether done by a human or using assistive technology, in English 10 and Français 10 have changed. A diagnosis of a learning disability or visual/perceptual impairment is no longer required. Students with a documented read-aloud adaptation who use it regularly in the classroom may access this adaptation on the examination whether or not a diagnosis is present.
