Literacy and Mathematics in Grade 3: Key Dates & Resources

The Nova Scotia Assessment: Literacy and Mathematics in Grade 3 (LM3) will be administered on four mornings in May. French Immersion students complete the Mathématiques component of the assessment; they do not write the literacy component.

New in 2024-25:

- The new LM3 Assessment Handbook replaces Checklists, Information Guide, and Administration Guide.
- All materials needed for administration will be mailed to schools in one package instead of two.
