About the Assessments

Students in grades 3, 4 and 6 write these assessments in September/October. Students in Grade 8 write the assessments in May/June. Nova Scotia teachers work with the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development to develop the assessments and to set the assessment expectations. The expectation is what students should know and be able to do on their own at the time of year of the assessment administration. All of the items and texts on the assessment are aligned with selected outcomes in the provincial curriculum.

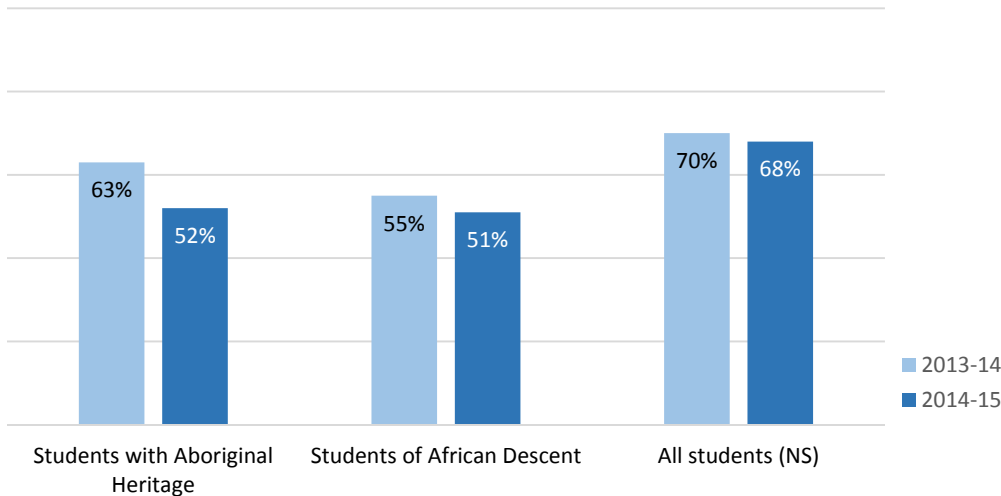
The results provide:

- teachers with information to inform instructional planning;
- parents and guardians with information on their child’s performance;
- the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development and school boards with information to inform educational decisions.

Students write Nova Scotia Assessments in grade 3, grade 4, grade 6, and grade 8.

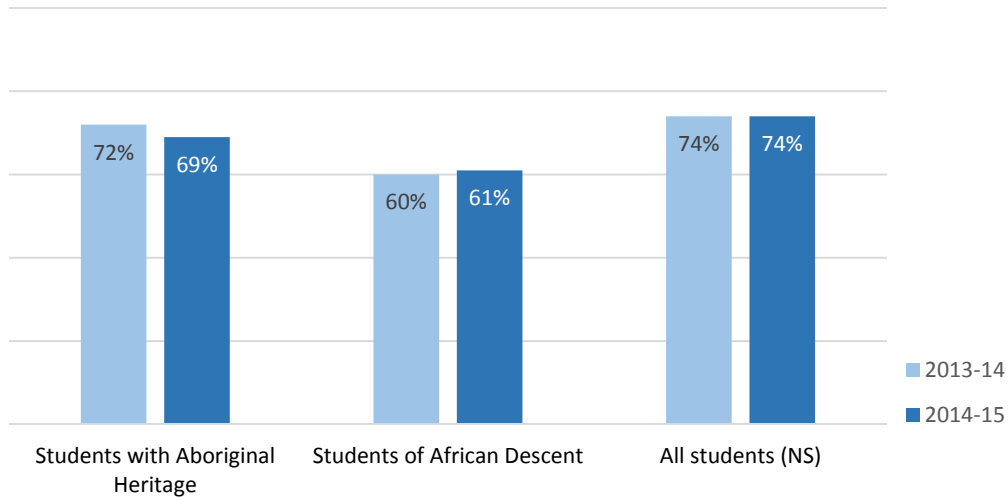
Assessment results do not affect report card grades or decisions about promotion or retention.

Percentage of students at or above the assessment expectation



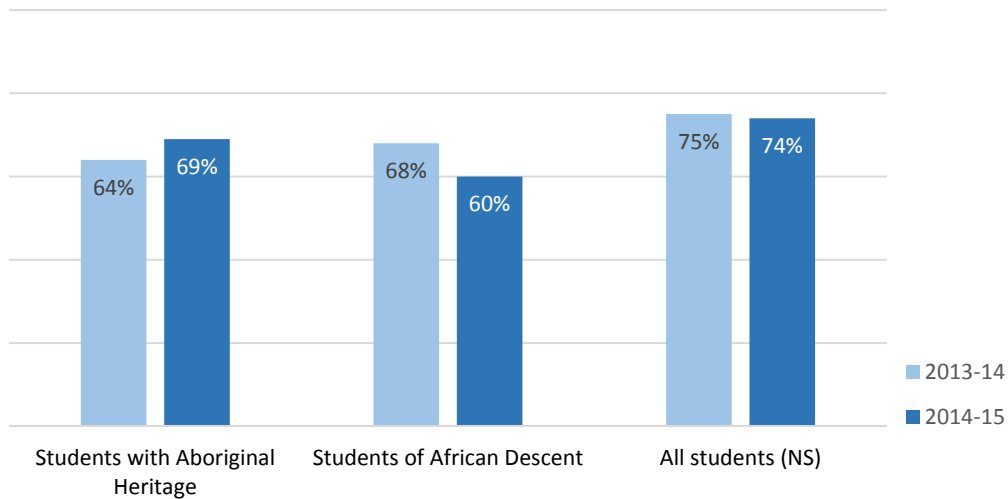

Percentage of students at or above the assessment expectation



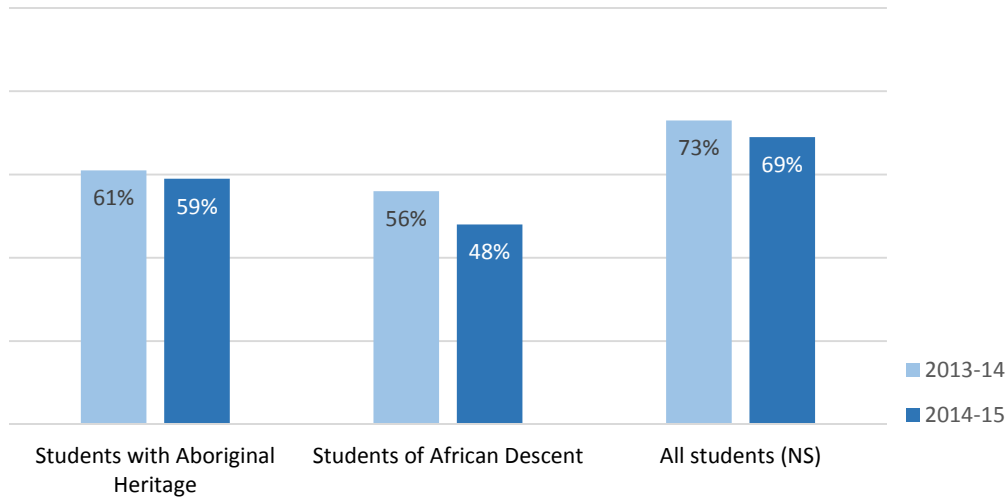

Percentage of students at or above the assessment expectation



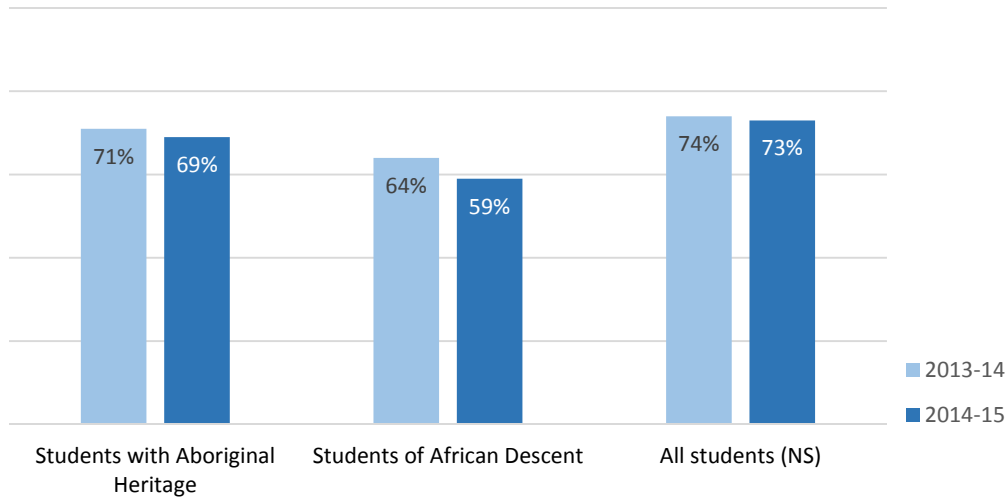

Percentage of students at or above the assessment expectation



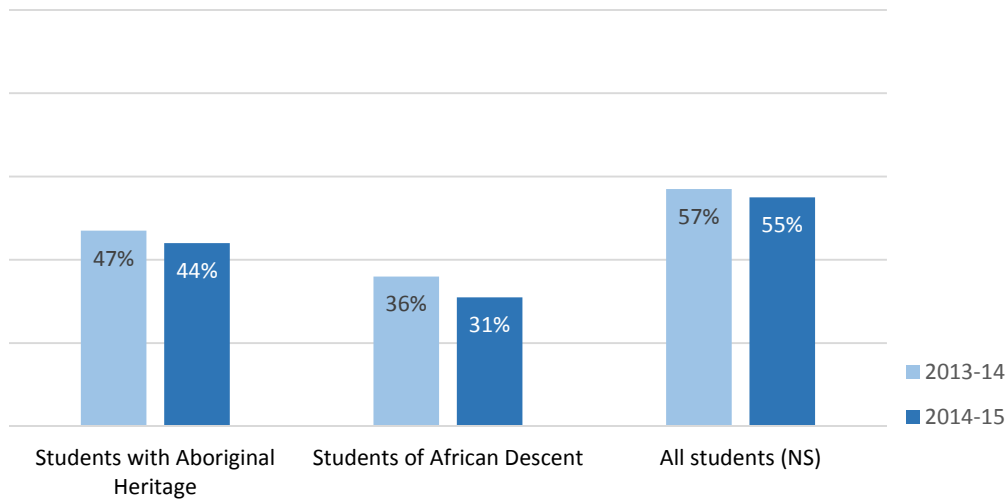
