Reading, Writing and Mathematics in Grade 8: Key Dates & Resources

The Nova Scotia Assessment: Reading, Writing, and Mathematics/Mathématiques in Grade 8 (RWM8) will be administered on four mornings in May and June. Students in the French Immersion program write the Mathématiques component of the assessment in French.

New in 2024-25:
